Details of Saturday Walks to Kedumba Hut

- 1. Meet at 9am at locked gate on Kedumba Pass at end of Kedumba Valley Rd, Wentworth Falls: <u>https://www.google.com.au/maps/dir//-33.770473,150.3759229/@-33.7329354,150.3423792,13z/data=!4m2!4m1!3e0</u>
- 2. Choose your walk down route:
 - a. Grade 2: Descend via fire trail through Kedumba Pass
 - b. Grade 5: Exploratory off-track down the Goat Track a difficult walk requiring reasonable navigation skills
- 3. Meet with NPWS ranger, Chris Banffy to explore the historic Kedumba Hut
- 4. Lunch by the Kedumba River
- 5. Choose your walk out route:
 - a. Grade 2: Explore surrounds of Kedumba Valley and return via the fire trail
 - b. Grade 5: Ascend to The Col on Mt Solitary via Solitary Pass before returning along walking track and fire trail

Please bring your own food, drinks, clothes, first aid, personal medicines, and day walk gear for this great day.

It is proposed to restore the <u>Maxwell's hut</u> to a "standard of function" as of its construction & use in the 1920's. The hut would provide basic overnight accommodation for bushwalkers, similar to the huts in the Kosciuszko National Park. In view of State heritage significance and other circumstances of the Kedumba Slab Hut, use of the Kedumba slab hut should be prearranged/booked. The proposed program of physical conservation works would make the hut habitable, secure and weather tight. Simple camp-style beds would be provided. Services and facilities, such as water, gas, electricity would not be permanently provided.
