
How can we keep the Warragamba dam wall as is?

To be presented by Harry Burkitt, Colong Foundation & Alex Allchin, Bushwalking NSW On *Tuesday 15th May, 2018 at Redfern Town Hall*

Hear about the latest in the NSW state government's plans to raise the Warragamba Dam wall. The proposal would, during flood events, inundate 4,700 hectares of pristine World Heritage listed national parks and 65 kilometres of wild rivers - twice the length of the Franklin River that was under threat in the 1980s.

How can bushwalkers help protect these precious, wild places?

Join us to learn about this issue from a bushwalker's perspective and learn how you can take action!

Harry Burkitt is Kowmung Campaigner for The Colong Foundation for Wilderness Ltd, and a student of Political History and Geology at Sydney University. Harry organised the very successful <u>Save the Blue Mountains</u> <u>Wild Rivers forum with Bob Brown and Bob Debus</u> and is coordinating the rapidly escalating campaign to stop the raising of the Warragamba Dam.

Harry will be supported by Alex Allchin, President of Bushwalking NSW Inc, also of The Colong Foundation for Wilderness Ltd, The Sydney Bush Walkers Activities Coordinator, and a student of geospatial science and engineering at UNSW. Alex led the very successful "Get out of the 'Gambe" campaign which saw Clarence Colliery receive the greatest fine in history for polluting the Wollongambe with coal fines.
