

Australian Activity Standards

It is proposed that guideline elements relating to good guidance for safe and non-invasive walking be supported but that BNSW object to unreasonable imposition and administration requirements on clubs in this regard.

The current Biodiversity Legislation Review will propose changes to NSW Biodiversity and Conservation Laws.

David Burgess from the Total Environment Centre spoke on the topic. He indicated that NSW and Australia has the worst extinction rates in the world. Threatened species have increased in the last five years mainly
