
Exploratory trips in the West MacDonnells

Meg has produced two books: one on the West MacDonnells (*Mountains of Discovery: Exploring the West MacDonnell Ranges - A Personal Account*) and the other on the Cockburn Range in the Kimberley (*Traversing the Cockburn Range*).
