7:40 Keynote speaker: Alex Allchin, President, Bushwalking NSW & Harry Burkitt, Kowmung Campaigner, Colong Foundation:

How can we keep the Warragamba dam wall the height it is?

- Alex Allchin spoke of the role Bushwalkers have played in forming, maintaining and defending the National Parks and World heritage areas in the Greater Blue Mountains region
- Harry Burkit spoke about the latest in the NSW state government's plans to raise the Warragamba Dam wall. The proposal would, during flood events, inundate 4,700 hectares of pristine World Heritage listed national parks and 65 kilometres of wild rivers - twice the length of the Franklin River that was under threat in the 1980s
- Both speakers talked of how bushwalkers can help protect these precious, wild places


