 - Worked with committee to develop the Bushwalking NSW Risk Management Guidelines.
 - Have since developed Discrimination and Harassment Guidelines & Child Protection policy
 - No longer the insurance officer
 - Did 4 years as president of BNSW

 - Raised in Canberra has always loved the outdoors and natural environment. Joined the Canberra BWC as
 - In late 20s move to Sydney and joined Span and then Bankstown BWC
 - Geologist and Soil Scientist with NSW Government
 - Will retire soon to bushwalk more with wife
 - Has volunteered on several committees
 - Joined BNSW to encourage bushwalking to be more relevant to younger people. The bushwalking movement needs a strong image that is seen as cool, exciting and adventurous.
