Club Emergency Contact Procedure

The following information enables suitable action to be taken in the event of an unexpected delay in a party's return.

BEFORE A WALK

Before a planned walk the leader provides the club with a route plan of the walk.

The route plan is to be submitted to the Activity Coordinator via the Activity Submission Form. This plan will be included in the Description section of the Club's Activities Program.

CLUB EMERGENCY CONTACTS

Members, please remember to tell your relatives and friends not to worry if you are late. Common reasons for being late include slower than expected progress of the group, a change in weather and unexpected track conditions.

If the group is delayed they will generally be able to make contact by the next morning. Day walkers who are properly equipped can survive a night out.

The Club Emergency Contacts are the first point of contact in the case of overdue parties, incidents or other emergencies. They have access to walk itineraries and other club records.

The list of Club Emergency Contacts can be found on the front page of the Activities Program.

Members are advised to forward this information to their Emergency Contact with the advice to ring a Club Emergency Contact if they are concerned about an unexpected delay in return.
